| <b>Who</b>       | The service is available to all international students in Duke Graduate School programs. |
| <b>When</b>      | Appointments can be requested for day, evening, or weekends.                             |
| <b>How long</b>  | Appointments usually last 30 to 90 minutes.  |
| <b>How often</b> | A student can usually schedule one appointment per week.                                 |
| <b>How soon</b>  | Students should request appointments as far in advance as possible.                      |
